

Contemporary Kyoto School

- Revisiting Pre-War Kyoto School:
- Nishida Kitaro: philosophy: <u>絶対無 Absolute</u> Nothing: Recognition of a place where oneself becomes a part of whole but cannot be seen
- Suzuki Daisetsu: religion: <u>霊性的自覚</u>
 <u>Spiritual Self Reflection</u>: To see the world and seen by the world; self reflection is the world
- Both were exercising ZEN of thirteen century Kamakura Buddhism

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Japan's place in the World

- Nishida: traditionally, Japan was a world vertically deep; after Meiji, met other countries, located wide horizontally → comprising the world and comprised by the world, aiming for harmony (1940)
- Suzuki: spiritual outburst from 大地 ground, covered by green grasses, deeply rooted in the ground, breezing free air without any restriction, and spreading branches to the eternal sky → complete harmony between spiritual Japan and spiritual world (1946)

Japan's Civilizational History

- Jomon Period: Country of Wood: Origin of philosophy of Coexistence with Nature → Shinto, coexistence with deity in universe
- Yayoi to Heian Period: Agriculture, culture, political system and Buddhism from China
- 神仏習合 Coexistence of Deity and Buddha
- 本地垂迹説 Honji Suijaku Setsu
- 神本仏迹説 Shinpon Butsujyaku Setsu
- 草木国土悉皆成仏 Grass and trees, national Land, all turning into Buddha → from Tendai Honkaku Buddhism (Saicho, Hieizan) to 13th century Kamakura Buddhism

So what?

- Accepting once everything; keeping it inside, at one point turning it into something unique, and then creating something universal.
