授業概要/Course outline

Do men and women have different brains? Are people born as women and men, or are "men" and "women" created by society? This lecture course will introduce you to different perspectives on gender in today's society. We will discuss to what extent gender is determined by biology and to what extent it is socially constructed. We will also look at how different cultures deal with the topic of gender differently. In class, we will study how gender affects aspects of daily life, for example, our language, how we are educated, what subjects we enjoy, what careers we are attracted to, the stories we hear as children, advertising and much more. Students will be encouraged to choose their own area of interest and research this for the duration of the semester. Students will present on this topic once during the semester and write a related research paper.

This is a content & language integrated course and therefore challenges advanced level students to discuss gender related issues in English. This class is interactive and involves many class discussions, increasing student confidence in discussing academic topics in English.
